Photographers' Special on the Conway Scenic Railroad

(Boston) - North Conway, NH -- Notchland & Return with classic F-7 locomotive 4266

Saturday, January 2, 2016 ONLY!!

There's just something special about a wintertime train excursion! Don't miss Mass Bay RRE's ninth annual photographers' special excursion on the **Conway Scenic Railroad**. Our unique event features multiple photo stops and photo runbys, this year starring Conway Scenic's classic cab-unit "covered wagon" diesel locomotive No. 4266. This locomotive, built by EMD in 1949 and now owned by the 470 Railroad Club of Portland, Maine, was the last "F unit" to operate on the Boston & Maine Railroad in 1976.

Our excursion will depart from the Conway Scenic's landmark North Conway station promptly at 10:30 AM, heading north and west through Bartlett to Notchland. There we'll reverse direction, with the 4266 leading us back to North Conway, making a number of stops, some accessible only by train, so passengers can take photographs and video of the train. Our return to North Conway is scheduled for 4:00 PM.

The train will consist of the dome car *Dorthea Mae*, the open-platform observation car *Gertrude Emma*, the first-class coach *Carroll P. Reed*, the table car *Mount Webster*, and two standard Conway Scenic coaches. All cars are heated and rest rooms are available on board. A limited number of premium seats are available in the dome section of the *Dorthea Mae* and in the parlor-observation car *Gertrude Emma*, which will be at the rear of our train on the return trip (extra fare & advance reservations required for seating in these cars - see order form below). Deluxe reserved Coach or booth seats are available in the *Carroll P. Reed* or the *Mount Webster* for a modest additional fare. Discounted fares are available to Mass Bay RRE members.

Our rest-room and video-equipped motorcoach will leave Boston's South Station at 7:00 AM and the Anderson RTC in Woburn at 7:15 AM. After our train's return there will be time to grab some photos around the station before the motorcoach departs, with a scheduled return to the Boston area around 8:00 PM. The Boston Connection Package includes a Box Dinner and beverage on the return trip from North Conway.

Train capacity is limited! Passengers wishing to sit together must order tickets together at the same time. Box lunches are available for advance purchase, or you may bring your own food. Also, the Conway Scenic snack counter on board will offer light snack and hot \mathcal{E} cold beverage service throughout the day.

All passengers will receive our detailed, full-color trip brochure, including route maps and descriptions of highlights along the route.
