'RDC RAMBLER' on the Conway Scenic Railroad

**North Conway, NH to Conway, Redstone, Notchland & Return with RDC-1 #23 "Millie"
Saturday, June 8, 2013 ONLY!!**

Members of the Mass Bay Railroad Enthusiasts and the Boston & Maine Railroad Historical Society and their guests are invited aboard for a leisurely ride over three portions of the Conway Scenic's tracks, with multiple photo opportunities along the way.

We'll depart from the landmark CSRR North Conway station at 10:30 AM. We'll start the day by heading south on the former Boston & Maine Conway Branch to Conway traveling past the Conway station to the end of the operable track as conditions allow. Then we will travel north, through North Conway to Mountain Junction, where we'll reverse direction and head east on the former Maine Central Mountain Division track, passing scenic Pudding Pond on our way to Redstone.

After a photo stop at the end of the operable track at Redstone, we reverse direction again and return to Mountain Junction, where a meet with CSRR train #20 will provide another photo opportunity. We'll then go on through Bartlett to Notchland before heading back to North Conway, making additional photo stops before our scheduled arrival at approximately 3:30 PM.. Photo stops and runbys are planned throughout the day as time and operating conditions allow.

About "Millie"

Conway Scenic's "Budd Car" car is an RDC-1 which was built for the New Haven Railroad in 1952 as their #23. It became Penn Central #68, then Amtrak #18, then Metro North #18 and was then sold to the NYSW where it was numbered M-5. As is the Conway Scenic tradition, the car reverted to its original number and became CSRR #23.

This special event is operated exclusively for members of Mass Bay RRE and the B&MRRHS and their guests. Train capacity is limited to just 80 seats!

We will reserve blocks of seats for groups of four or more persons only. There will be no snack or beverage service aboard "Millie" for this trip. Box lunches from Chef's Market in North Conway are available for advance purchase, or you may bring your own food.

This trip operates ONE DAY ONLY, rain or shine. All sales are final and tickets are not refundable. Alcoholic beverages and smoking will not be permitted aboard this train. Tickets will be mailed to you about 10 days prior to the trip; we will send driving directions to the departure point in North Conway with your tickets. Please notify us if special accommodations (handicap seating, etc.) are required.
